Project title	SMART MDT in Type 2 Diabetes

Aims and objectives of the project	The SMART MDT (SMART MDT – Set up and Mobilise, Accelerate, Resources and Tools Multi-disciplinary team) in Type 2 Diabetes (T2DM) project aims to transform the capacity, capability and confidence of the entire primary care workforce to deliver better patient outcomes in T2DM care.
	This Collaborative Working project will support Nottingham City GP Alliance (NCGPA) to improve their T2DM pathway utilising the whole primary care MDT skillset. This will incorporate utilisation of the innovative, web based Soar Beyond SMART platform with capability mapping function and will produce a robust costed business case to deliver an implementation strategy based on workforce and service development priorities. With an understanding of current service gaps and utilisation of the SMART platform, the intention is to deliver role specific diabetes training and upskilling to better utilise the entire workforce and free up clinical capacity and support the delivery of T2DM healthcare.
Time period (from/to)	The project will commence in January 2022 and run for two years until December 2023. Results of this project will be published on the Novo Nordisk website within 6 months of project completion.

	The overall SMART MDT Collaborative Working project has been designed to identify current service gaps and create a model which utilises the most appropriate healthcare professional in the T2DM patient pathway to support the patient living with T2DM to
